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EDCTP Until 2024



- Established in 2003 by a co-decision of the European Parliament and Council: Article 185 Initiative (Ex 169)
- EDCTP-1: 2003-2015
- **EDCTP-2: 2014-2024**
- **Official Launch: 2 Dec 2014, Cape Town, SA**
- Objective: Clinical development of effective, safe, accessible, suitable and affordable medical interventions for poverty related and **neglected** diseases (**PRNIDs**) in partnership with sub-Saharan African countries

From EDCTP1 to EDCTP2 What is different?

- **New legal structure:** From EEIG to Association under Dutch law
- **Expanded membership:** Countries in sub-Saharan Africa can become full members with rights and obligations
- **Broader scope:** Phase I + IV trials + health services optimisation research + NIDs + diagnostics
- **Increased magnitude:** possibility for larger, more ambitious projects
- **Relationship with EC:** From grant to delegation agreement
- **Project funding:** 100% funding + 25% indirect costs – no cofunding requirement at the project level (unless in specific cases)
- **Private sector participation:** Pharmaceutical companies can participate and receive funding
- **Operational process:** Annual work plan, approved by EDCTP General Assembly and EC

EDCTP-TDR Fellowships: Open for application on 31 Oct 2014

Maximum funding per project:	Up to € 100,000 per year
Expected nr/duration of grants:	25 (10 by EDCTP) / up to 24 months
Eligibility criteria:	1 European PS and 1 SSA country
Submission/evaluation process:	Single-stage (Full proposal)

Diagnostic Tools: Open for application on 2 Dec 2014

Maximum funding per project:	€ 3.0 M
Expected nr/duration of grants:	4-8 / 36-60 months
Eligibility criteria:	> 2 European PSs & 1 SSA country
Submission/evaluation process:	Two-stage (LoI; full proposal)

Maximising the impact of EDCTP-funded research: opening in Dec Q4 2014

Maximum funding per project:	€ 500,000
Expected nr/duration of grants:	6-8 / 24-36 months
Eligibility criteria (CSAs):	> 1 European PSs or 1 SSA country
Submission/evaluation process:	Single-stage (Full proposal)

- Accelerate translation of research findings **from EDCTP projects into policy and practice** in order to maximise their public health impact in SSA
- Translation and uptake of research findings into policy-making, health systems or clinical practice; developing methodological tools for translation into public health programmes/practices; or optimising strategies for widespread adoption or research results

- Treatment and clinical management
- Strategic co-funding of major trials (topics not covered by other calls, 50% costs, up to 10M Euros)
- Networks-of-Excellence
- Ethics and Regulatory grants
- Fellowships
 - Senior fellowships
 - Career development fellowships
 - EDCTP-TDR industry fellowships
